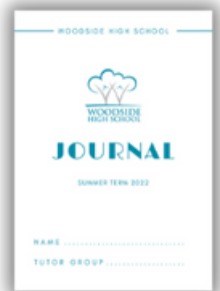

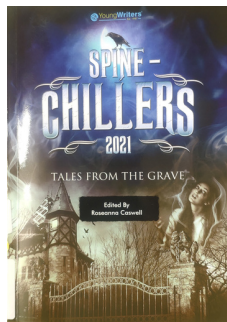
SPINE CHILLERS
