

On Friday, students took part in the first house event of the term. Year 7 students were tasked to navigate, using a detailed map, to track down and bring back flags located around the school. Here are the results:



- . You MUST be on time for all your exams. If you are late the awarding body will be notified and they may not accept your work for marking
- . If you are sick on the day of an exam, you MUST contact the school as soon as possible
- . You MUST be in FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM for ALL your exams
- Mobile phones, watches <u>earpods</u> are to be handed to an invigilator **before** students enter the exam room
