MUSIC TRIP

Elective Highlight

Journalism

Year 9 students from the journalism elective enjoyed a trip to the Houses of Parliament on Wednesday. Pupils were given a tour of the Palace of Westminster, where they learnt about the 900-year history of the home of UK politics.

Students walked through the grand chambers including the House of Lords, where they learned about how laws are made and how MPs vote. Here, they even bumped into a sitting Peer who chatted with pupils about Woodside, politics and school life. Pupils later witnessed the procession of the leader of the House of Commons into Prime Minister's Questions. Hornsey and Wood Green MP Catherine West then came and met our students, before having a chat and taking photos outside Parliament looking onto the London Eye. Students finished the day by walking along Parliament Street to Trafalgar Square, taking in Big Ben, the Sir Winston Churchill Statue and the Cenotaph.

Rana Aldukali, from Year 9, chatted with Catherine West MP about school life and international politics. Rana said: "It was such an honour to speak with someone so important who represents our area and our school in Parliament. We had a fantastic day."
