Competitions this term include:

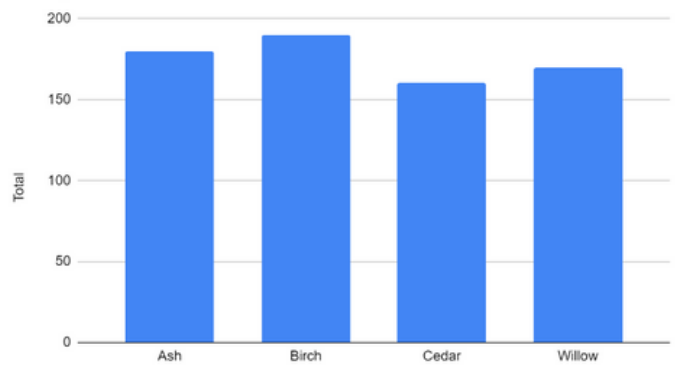

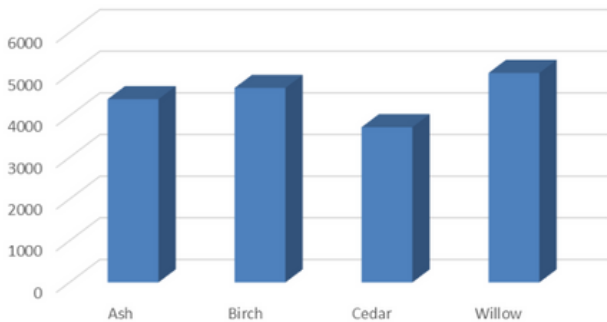
Here is how each house is getting on in the competition.

Below you will find the praise total, along with the breakdown for each house.

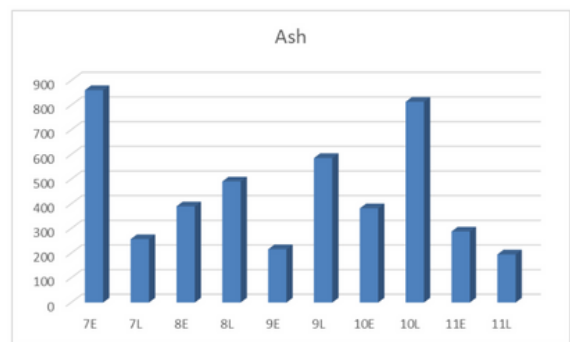
Competition Points



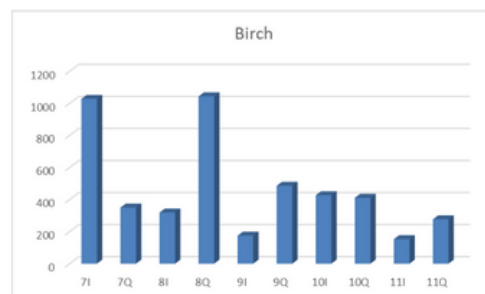
Total Praise Points



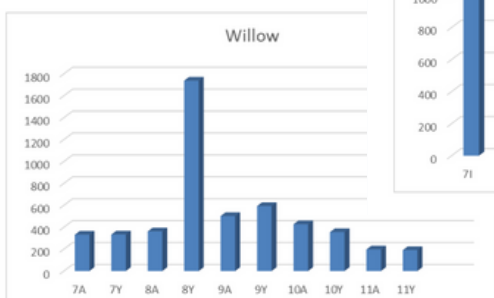
