HOW TO STUDY AT HOME

HOW WILL I KNOW WHAT TO STUDY?

Your teachers will set your work on Google Classroom.

You will need to login using your school email. If you are unsure of how to login to Google Classroom, take a look at the student access guide.

Your teacher will give you clear instructions of how to complete the task and how to hand in your work when you have completed it.

WHEN SHOULD I STUDY?

You should follow your normal school timetable. For example, if you have Science period 1 on Monday, you should login for your live lesson at 08.50

If you are at home with other people, you could also read aloud to them. You can also complete quizzes for Renaissance Reading; this is available to you from home!

WHAT WILL HAPPEN ONCE I COMPLETE MY WORK?

- Your teacher will tell you what to do with your work once you have completed it, this may include, self assessing your work during a live lesson, handing in your work via Google Classroom or emailing it to your teacher.
- In many cases you can mark your own work or if you have a classmate online, you could peer assess your work.
- Your parents and careers and older siblings would be really interested in hearing all about your work.
- Teachers will try to be as available to you online as much as possible. You can message them in chat during a live lesson, email them or post any questions on Google Classroom and they will try to get back to you as soon as they can.

WHAT SHOULD I DO AT BREAK AND LUNCHTIME?

Take a rest, look after your mental health. What about using the free Headspace website/app to help you? What about some 'living room' workout time? There are plenty of online tutorials on Youtube for simple quick exercise routines you can do at home.

WHAT IF I COMPLETE ALL OF MY WORK?

If you complete all of the work set by your teachers, there are lots of other activities you can complete.

You could ...

- Create revision mind maps for key topics
- Create flashcards for key topics
- Test yourself using your knowledge organiser
- Set up a web chat with a friend to discuss key topics in the news
- Read an online book or take a quiz on Accelerated reader (see below)
