Dear Parent/Carer,

The last two years during the covid pandemic has put many strains on the experiences our young people can enjoy. One of the areas that many young people have missed out on are school trips and visits. We believe at Woodside that learning in different ways and having different experiences can have a profound impact on a young person. Therefore we are offering a series of trips for all students on **Monday 18th July 2022**. These are being universally offered to all students, however, students will be expected to demonstrate the highest level of positive behaviours in the run up and on the trip itself.

All trips have been subsidised by school but we are requesting a parental contribution which will support with the cost of transport and admission fees. There is also the opportunity for free trips or to contact us if you need support in paying for the trip. Students may also need money for lunch and drinks or they can bring a packed lunch with them. Students with Free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch. This will be a non-uniform day.

All trips have been added to your ParentPay account and consent is also on ParentPay. The cut-off date to reserve a place on the trip is **Friday 24th June**. Pupil premium money will not be used to fund this trip but it can be paid in installments.
