Governing body at Mulberry Academy Woodside

I am writing to inform you about the current governing and Trust body arrangements at Mulberry Academy Woodside. All schools have a local governing body of whom the Headteacher and the senior team present an update on school priorities, development areas and KPIs (key performance indicators such as results, finance etc). The governing body can also play an important role in supporting parents and providing a link between school and home. The role of the governing body is to challenge and develop the staffing body to provide the best education for young people at their school.

In a move to a new Trust the historic governing body ceases to exist and a new one is formed. All our governors have been asked if they would like to continue and we are pleased that four of our current governors will be remaining with us. We have been fortunate to secure a new Chair of Governors, Alice Crawley. Alice has been the Chair of governors at the Trust for time and is incredibly experienced Governor. In addition to this group, we go out for a new election on staff governor, parent governors and then one additional community governor. We will be holding parent governor elections soon and details will follow shortly.

Since May we have been reporting into the termly meetings for finance, standards, and the full Trust board. This ensures that we are accountable in this interim period, as we enter September our local governing body meetings will resume on a termly basis.
