
DEAR PARENTS AND CARERS,



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Year 11 travel to Belgium to learn at Euro Space Centre

A group of ten year 11 students went to the Euro Space centre in Belgium with Ms Alpdogan.

They were joined with a group of students from LAET and Park View. They engaged with lectures on cosmology and the history of space exploration in the auditorium.

Students took part in a range of activities in the space centre including: going down a free fall slide; space mission simulation; rocket building and launching activity; taking part in a VR moon walk and mars walk; experiencing a multi axis chair used to train astronauts and feeling the effects of centripetal force in a space rotor.

Of course, no trip abroad would be complete without a cultural visit. The students explored the grounds of Sedan castle, the largest fortified castle in Europe. They also had the opportunity to visit the Caves of Han, a complex system of limestone caves formed over millions of years, famous for its geological formations of stalactites and stalagmites.

Overall, the students had an amazing time at the Euro Space centre and said it was a once in a lifetime experience to remember.


Most people really appreciated the show and found it easy to follow along with, making it perfect to help us with the revision we were doing then.
