

<u>Ambitious about Autism</u> is one of nine not-for-profit organisations that make up <u>Autism Central</u>. The project provides parents and carers of autistic people free and easy access to autism education, training, and support.

Together with <u>Contact</u>, we run the London hub. Our hub offers group and one-to-one sessions to help you and other parents and carers find the information and services available in your area. We may also run events such as workshops, drop-in sessions, coffee mornings or virtual meetups. The sessions are delivered by Peer Educators with lived experience of autism.

In September, we'll be running free sessions about autism, including:

- Wellbeing for parents and carers
- Autism and education
- · Understanding autism for personal assistants and paid carers
- Understanding your child's behaviour
