



Michele Obama's book 'Becoming' was given to every student to take home and read.





Punctuality

Being on time to school is a key life skill. Gates close at 8.40am at Mulberry Academy Woodside and learning starts soon after.

The school provides free breakfast for all children from 7.30am daily so please try and encourage your child to attend this.

If your child is 5 minutes late every day, this equates to nearly 3 whole days of missed learning, plus it is disruptive for other children.

If your child is late for school, they must complete a late form on the same day in room C002.

Failure to do so will result in an SLT detention after school on Wednesday/Friday.

Please ensure your child is on time to school before 8.40am each day.
