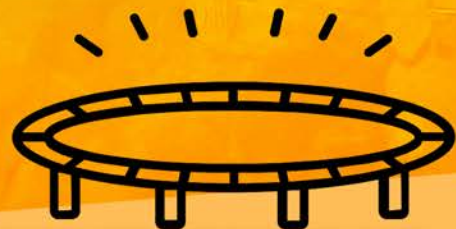

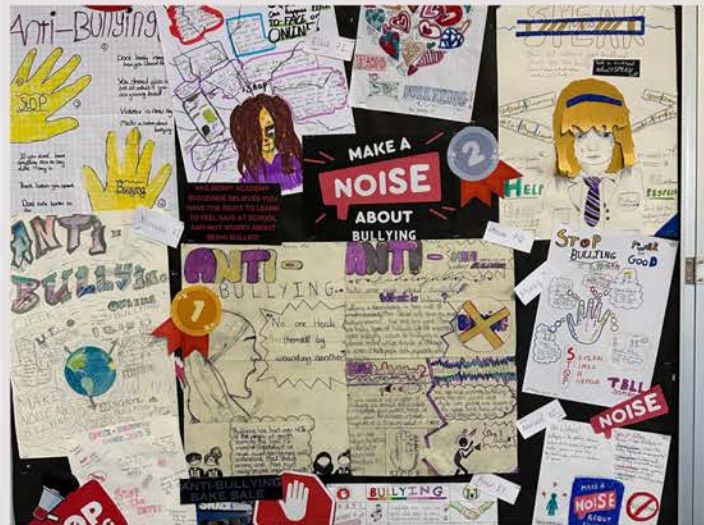

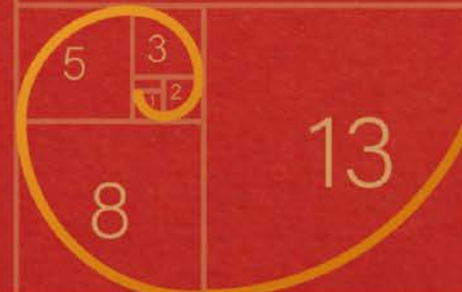
EXCITING CINEMA TRIP FOR YEAR 10 FILM STUDIES STUDENTS!
