Massive congratulations to the year 7 netball team who secured a win against parkview Academy this week as well as coming 4th in the borough at a netball festival.





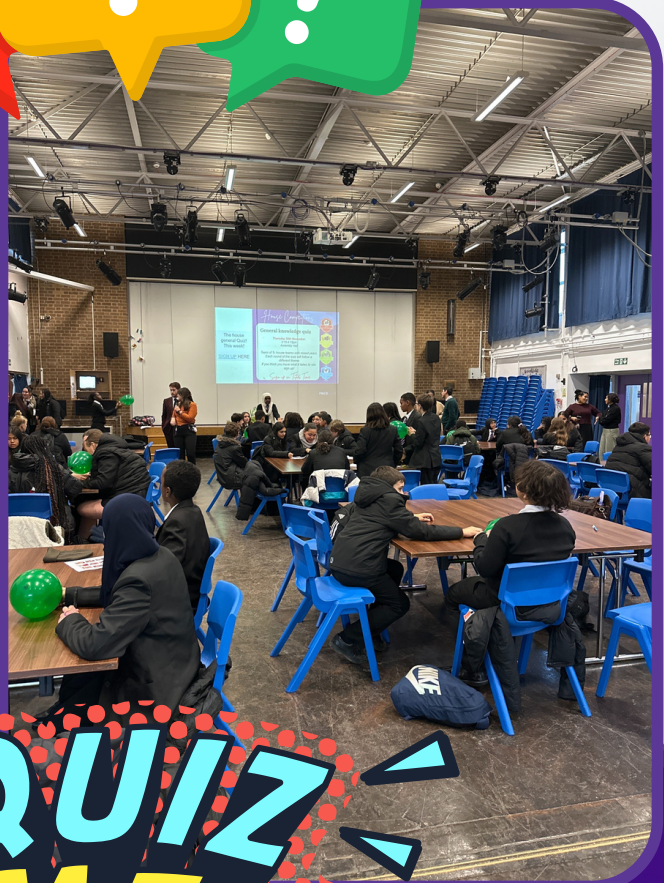
GENERAL KNOWLEDGE QUIZ
