Mulberry Schools Trust Interschools Benchball Competition

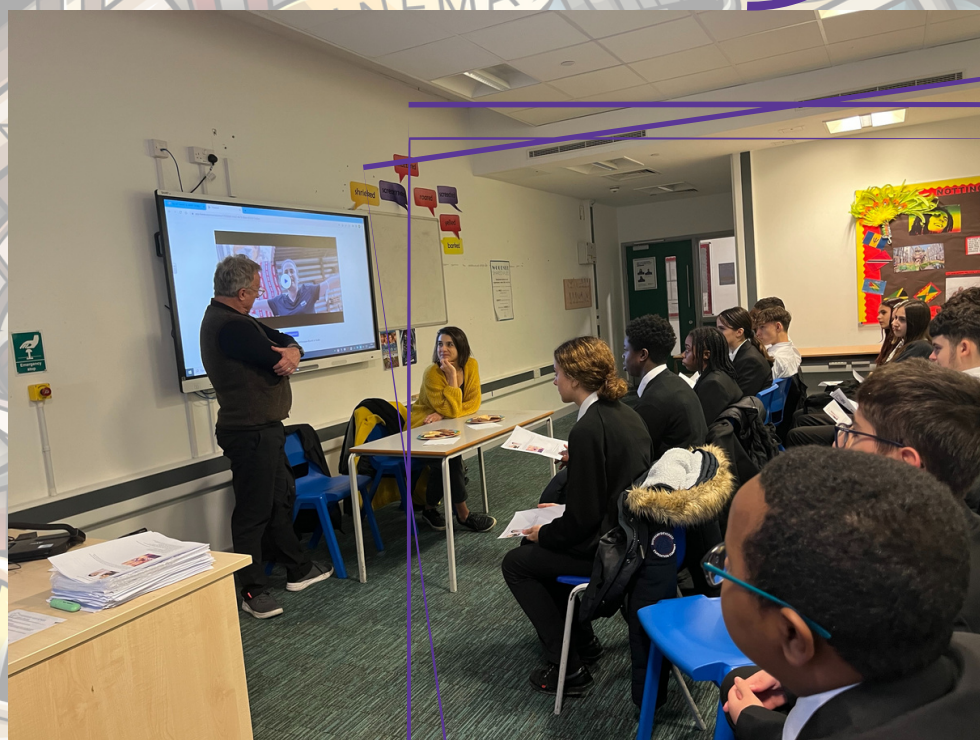
AT MULBERRY ACADEMY SHOREDITCH
