#### VITAL INFORMATION

The aim of the course is to equip students to be able to survive in the country of their chosen language either during a short stay or a holiday. The course builds on the foundations of KS3 covering in greater depth each of the common topic areas. Students will need to have a passion for language learning, good problem solving skills and not be afraid to make mistakes. Students will develop their linguistic abilities in grammar and oracy while expanding their cultural awareness of Francophone countries.

#### CURRICULUM CONTENT

An engaging and inspirational French course that will enable students to manipulate and use the target language effectively, independently and creatively, so that they have a solid basis from which to progress to A Level or employment/study at home and abroad.

The Pearson Edexcel Level 1/Level 2 GCSE in Spanish (9-1) allows students to develop their ability to communicate with French native speakers in both speech and writing. They will study a variety of topics and themes relevant to their age and interests. These Themes are: Identity and culture; Local area, holiday and travel; School; Future aspirations, study and work; International and global dimension.

Students will develop their note taking skills, reading for gist, translation skills and writing in a range of registers. They will manipulate new grammatical concepts to understand how a language works and develop their own independent use of a foreign language.

Students will need to develop and use their knowledge and understanding of French grammar progressively through their course of study. To help students build on their range of vocabulary, a list is provided of words that students are expected to use and understand as well as a grammar booklet and GCSE course booklet to guide them throughout their 2 years of study.
