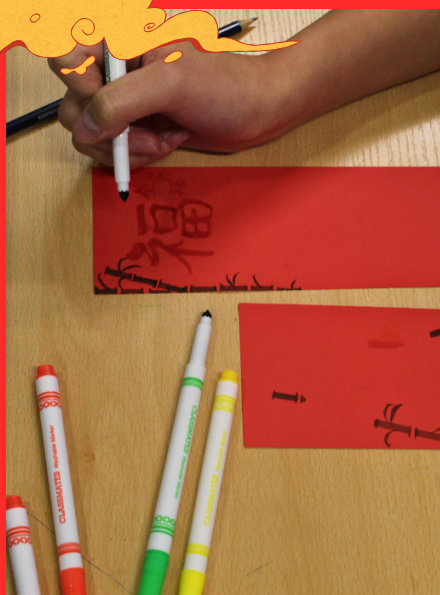



Next year celebrates 30th anniversary of British Science Week, so the theme this year celebrates the passing of time since the Week began, and looking to the future!




