Newroz, the Kurdish New Year, is a delightful spring festival cherished across many cultures spanning the Middle East, Central Asia, and South Asia. It's a time of renewal and optimism deeply rooted in the traditions of Zoroastrianism. During Newroz, people gather outdoors for festivities, indulge in delicious feasts, and take part in meaningful rituals such as leaping over bonfires.

However, Newroz is more than just a cultural event; it holds profound historical and political significance for Kurdish communities. It symbolises their enduring spirit in the face of adversity, reflecting their resilience against oppression.









On the 18th of March, Woodside came alive with the vibrant celebrations of Newroz. Students, staff, and parents joined hands to create a memorable afternoon filled with music, scrumptious food, and plenty of joyful dancing!

On 20th March, Woodside hosted its first iftar, to which both Muslim and non-Muslim students, parents, carers, and staff were warmly invited. Iftar is the evening meal with which Muslims end their daily Ramadan fast at sunset. They break their fast at the time of the call to the evening prayer.


# International HAPPY PDDA OTOS


- 3 Construction all around.
