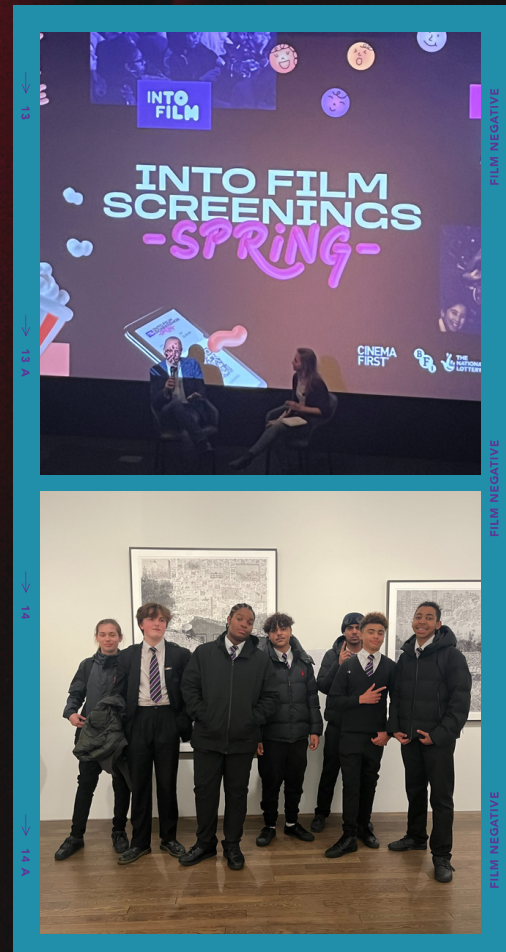
FILM STUDIES

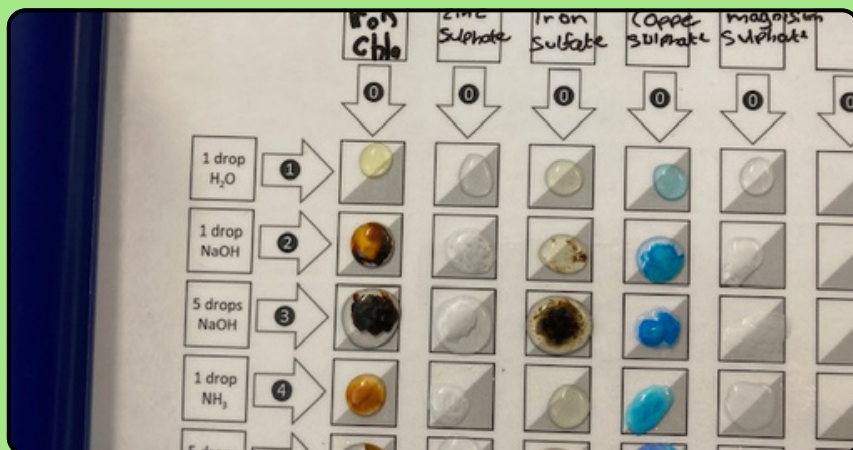
Before our return to school, students also visited The Photographers' Gallery to compare still photography and moving photography (films).


