GLOBAL GIRLS LEADING

Global Girl Leading is a Mulberry Schools Foundation Changemakers Project.

For over 15 years, Mulberry schools have run conferences focused on supporting the leadership, confidence and voices of girls and young women.

On 11th October, The Mulberry Schools Trust (MST) are organising and hosting an international summit for girls' leadership and education called "Global Girls Leading conference." A girls' school in Kenya called Lenana Girls' High School (a school that offers vulnerable and orphaned girls an education) contacted MST and asked if they might support their attendance at the event.

They are paying for flights and we have committed to raising the funds to pay for their accommodation and subsistence while they are here in London - The target across the Trust is £3000 and because of this, our students put on a bake sale which ran over 3 days to help raise funds.



FROGRAMS FROM ERS

As part of our careers curriculum, it was a first taste of the world of work this week for fourteen Year 10 students who are taking part in our Future Frontiers programme at the head office of digital telecoms and broadband company Liberty Global, based in Hammersmith.




