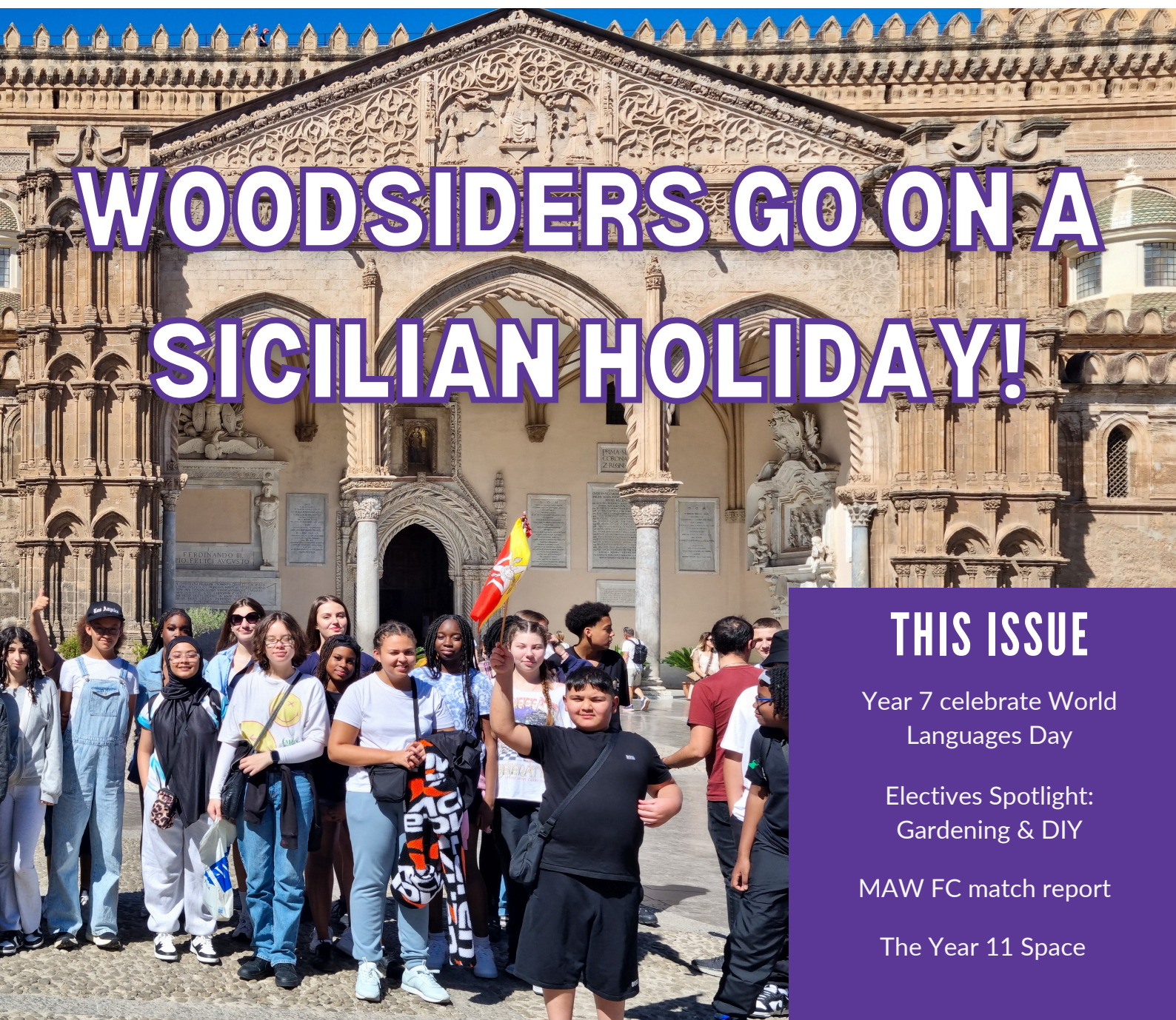

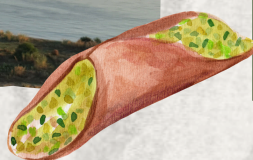

ENGLISH TOP TIP FROM MS CUTHBERT ON FLASHCARDS

When making and using flashcards:

Do:

- ...make flashcards quickly.
- ...include concise pieces of information of each flashcard.
- ...sort your flashcards according to their confidence with them.
- ...test themselves on the flashcards from memory.

Don't:

- X ...spend more time *making* flashcards than actually using them.
- X ...put paragraphs of information onto each flashcard.
- X ...revise the flashcards in the same order every time that they use them.
- X ...only read through flashcards.

10th October is **World Mental Health Day**. This year's theme set by the World Federation of Mental Health is workplace mental health. The theme highlights the importance of addressing mental health and wellbeing in the workplace, for the benefit of people, organisations, and communities.

There are lots of ways that you can take part in World Mental Health Day. You can use the social media hashtag #WMHD2024 to see what companies are doing to celebrate and raise awareness, this may be wearing a green ribbon to show support, holding a Tea & Talk, or getting running an event to showcase how they support their employee's mental health.



Talking is good for your mental health. And talking about mental health is important. But starting a conversation isn't always easy. Whether you'd like to talk to someone about how you're feeling, or check-in with someone you care about, here are some tips that can help.



Every year 1 in 4 of us will experience a mental health problem. Nearly 2 million are waiting for NHS mental health services, and since 2017 the number of young people struggling with mental health has doubled. Mind have set out the steps the new UK government must take towards a future where there's no mind left behind.



If you're thinking of a career in mental health, here are some job roles that you may wish to consider: Mental Health Nurse | Child Psychotherapist | Occupational Therapist & Art Therapist
